Dear Fall 2021 OCS Students,

You may be wondering how Whitman's COVID vaccination requirement will impact OCS students. We would like to reiterate the message that President Murray has shared with the Whitman community regarding COVID vaccinations. Proof of COVID vaccination will be required for **all Whitman students** in order for students to be enrolled in the fall. This includes all students enrolled in Fall 2021 OCS programs. **Students who choose not to get vaccinated, with a very narrow exception for medical and religious reasons, will not be allowed to enroll at Whitman and will need to take a leave of absence.**

It is imperative that you make a plan for a vaccination **sooner** rather than later. There are many **locations** in Walla Walla that are offering vaccines. To find a location, simply follow this **link**. It is important to note that study abroad providers may also require proof of vaccination prior to your departure.

One last item, if you have been fully vaccinated, remember to fill out the Whitman **[COVID-19 Vaccination Reporting Form](#)** as soon as possible.
