

April 21 – Action Items for 2020FA OCS Students: Setting up your “Plan B”

Hello again Fall 2020 OCS students,

This is a friendly reminder that all Fall 2020 OCS students need to take these two critical steps as soon as possible so that you will have a "Plan B" in case you are not able to study off campus this fall:

1. Register for Fall 2020 courses on the Whitman campus during the pre-registration period May 1-5. Please talk with your major adviser soon about your on-campus course selection. (If you ultimately are able to study abroad in the fall, you can simply notify the Whitman Registrar at that time that you are dropping the Whitman classes.)

2. Sign up for Whitman on-campus housing for Fall 2020. All students should have received an email today from Residence Life about completing the Res Life form to request housing. We highly recommend that you sign up for on-campus housing this fall, so that you will have a place to live in case you are unable to study off campus next semester. Note that there is **no housing deposit required** to reserve housing on-campus at Whitman for Fall 2020. If you have specific questions, please contact Amy Bruner in Residence Life at brunerae@whitman.edu.

We hope you don't need your Plan B and that you will all be able to study off campus next semester, but we want you to have resources in place so that you are able to continue to make progress toward graduation if study abroad programs aren't available.

If you are considering switching to a spring 2021 OCS program instead of fall 2020 and need assistance, please contact your OCS adviser (me or Barbara Hoffman) for assistance.
